38.1 The Foundation TSubject to paragraph 39.2 below no amendment to this Constitution shall be valid unless it has been approved by two thirds of those Governors present and voting at a meeting of the AssemblyCouncil of Governors and has subsequently been approved by Monitor.

Any amendment to this Constitution which requires:

any amendment to the boundaries of the Public Constituency (as set out in Annex 1 of the Constitution) and/or the boundaries of the Staff Constituency (as set out in Annex 2 of the Constitution); or

any amendment to the numbers of Governors comprising the Assembly Council of Governors as set out in Annex 3 of the Constitution;

40.1 shall only be valid where it has been approved by two thirds of the Members present and voting at a meeting duly called by order of the Assembly Council of Governors in accordance with this Constitution and has subsequently been approved by Monitor. rust may make amendments of its constitution only if:

40.1.1 More than half of the members of the Council of Governors of the Foundation Trust voting approve the amendments; and

40.1.2 More than half of the members of the Board of Directors of the Foundation Trust voting approve the amendments.

40.2 Amendments made under paragraph 40.1 take effect as soon as the conditions in that paragraph are satisfied, but the amendment has no effect in so far as the constitution would, as a result of the amendment, not accord with schedule 7 of the 2006 Act.

40.3 Where an amendment is made to the constitution in relation to the powers or duties of the Council of Governors (or otherwise with respect to the role that the Council of Governors has as part of the Foundation Trust):

40.3.1 At least one member of the Council of Governors must attend the next Annual Members' meeting and present the amendment; and

- 40.3.2 The Foundation Trust must give the members an opportunity to vote on whether they approve the amendment.
- 40.4 If, in accordance with paragraph 40.3, more than half of the members voting approve the amendment to the constitution in relation to the powers or duties of the Council of Governors, the amendment continues to have effect. Otherwise, the amendment ceases to have effect and the Foundation Trust must take such steps as are necessary as a result.
- 40.5 Amendments by the Foundation Trust of its constitution are to be notified to Monitor. For the avoidance of doubt, Monitor's functions do not include a power or duty to determine whether or not the constitution, as a result of the amendments, accords with Schedule 7 of the 2006 Act.

39-41. Mergers

The Foundation Trust may only apply for a merger, acquisition, separation or dissolution of the Foundation Trust with the approval of more than half of the members of the Council of Governors The Foundation Trust may in accordance with section 56 of the 2006 Act apply to Monitor jointly with another NHS Foundation Trust or an NHS Trust for authorisation of the dissolution of the Foundation Trust and the transfer of some or all of their property and liabilities to a new NHS Foundation Trust established under that section. Such application shall only be made if it is approved by not less than two thirds of the present and voting members of the Foundation Trust present and voting at a members' meeting duly called by order of the AssemblyCouncil of Governors in accordance with this cConstitution.
