




How do I obtain the full text of a journal article?



You can search for journal articles, conference procedures etc. using the Knowledge Hub which can be accessed via the library webpages. (https://www.wuth.nhs.uk/choose-us/for-library-and-knowledgeservices).

To get to the hub and access locally purchased resources, as well as NHS Core Content, please click on 'Search'.

On the following screen click on the yellow bar at the top of page and enter your Open Athens username and password. (Please note if you do not have an Open Athens username or you have forgotten your password, please contact a member of library staff or alternatively use this URL to register https://openathens.nice.org.uk).

Within the Hub there are **three ways** you can access full text of articles:



- 1. 'Browse Journals' to see the titles we provide access to.
- Search by subject, speciality or title
- Click on the image of the journal you would like to browse
- Select the volume and issue you would like to browse
- To read an article click on the PDF symbol to download the full text.


2. 'Journals A-Z'

Enter the title of the journal you are looking for (or search by subject). The entry for the journal will look this:

- Note the years of 'Full Text Access' by different suppliers
- Click on the supplier who provides coverage for the years you require.
- You will be taken to the supplier site where you can browse and download the articles require. **Please note**. Suppliers vary how they provide access. Some have specific requirements please see overleaf for more information.

3. Searching for journal articles.

When using the knowledge hub to search for a specific article or for all resources on a specific topic, the results will be listed as shown below.

Access Item

Where the full text of an article is available you will see either 'Get PDF', 'Access Item' or 'View Complete Issue' Simply click on any of these links to see the full text. (As mentioned earlier there are a couple of anomalies—please see below for further information).

Where you are presented with 'Request this item' this means we cannot provide immediate access to the article. However, click on the link, complete the form you are presented with and then submit. Library staff will then endeavour to locate a copy of the article for you.

View Complete Issue

Emerald Research Pass: Access to the full text of articles published by Emerald Publishing varies. Depending on whether the article is freely available or otherwise, you may be presented with different options. In some cases you will be taken directly to the PDF or full text online. However, you may find you are taken to the publisher web page for the journal and see the following:
