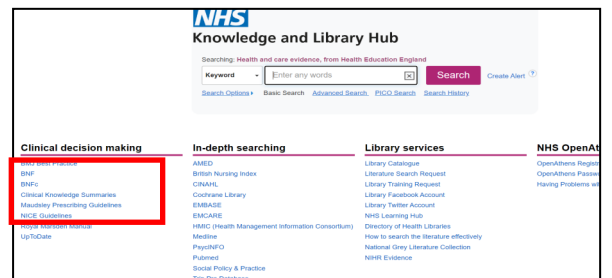

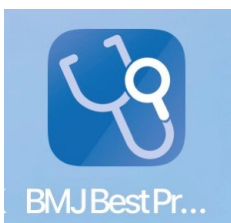


1. Go to <http://bestpractice.bmj.com/info>
