His loss will be felt deeply across the Trust, particularly within the Eye Department and Radio Clatterbridge, where he volunteered regularly.

Andy's sister, Vikky, warmly invites staff and volunteers to attend his Celebration of Life service at Landican South Chapel on Friday 5th December at 2.30pm.



The cortege will pass the Arrowe Park Hospital site at approximately 2.05 to 2.10pm, and colleagues who cannot attend the service are welcome to gather at the site entrance to pay their respects.

After the service, friends, family and colleagues are invited to the Conservative Club in Oxton Village. Vikky is especially keen to hear stories and memories of Andy, reflecting the impact he had on so many.

Attendees are encouraged to wear a splash of yellow, symbolising the sunshine he brought to people's lives, or orange, representing his valued volunteering.
