Student Nursing Associate Apprenticeship Opportunity

An exciting opportunity has arisen for colleagues interested in joining the Student Nursing Associate (SNA) Apprenticeship Programme, delivered in partnership with the University of Chester.

This two-year foundation degree programme leads to registration with the Nursing and Midwifery Council as a Registered Nursing Associate. The course blends academic study with practice-based learning and is mapped to the Nursing Associate Standards of Proficiency (NMC 2018) and the Nursing Associate Higher Apprenticeship Standards (2021).

The programme requires a 37.5-hour working week, including one full study day per week at the University of Chester. The Trust will support you in developing your clinical skills and applying theory to practice throughout your working week.

You will complete three placements each year, gaining experience across Adult, Learning Disability, Mental Health, Children's services, and care delivered at home, in the community, and in hospital settings.

The course commences March 2026.

If you are committed to delivering person-centred care and wish to develop professionally, clinically and personally, this secondment opportunity could be the next step in your career.
