Living Well Bus Comes to WUTH

The Living Well Bus is visiting WUTH over the coming months, offering community-focused health support built on the principles of listening, inclusion and meeting people where they are. The service is delivered by Cheshire and Wirral Partnership NHS Foundation Trust and runs on a fully drop-in basis, with no booking required.

The bus will provide routine UK immunisations, health checks and mental wellbeing support, placing preventative care and early intervention at the heart of community health. Available to staff, patients and visitors, the service includes blood pressure, pulse, cholesterol, blood glucose, and BMI checks, as well as direct referrals into Talking Therapies for ongoing support.



Drop-in cervical screening (smear tests) will also be available to those eligible, supported in a private clinical space on board.

The bus will be on site on Wednesday 7th January 2025 near Allied Pharmacy at Arrowe Park, Friday 13th February 2025 near Elm House at Clatterbridge, and Wednesday 4th March 2025 again at Arrowe Park near Allied Pharmacy.
