An award-winning garden from the RHS Flower Show at Tatton Park (pictured right) that was donated to us in 2023 and replanted in the grounds at Clatterbridge Hospital, is being expanded.

The Constructing Minds with Nature team, who created the garden, have continued their support and are working on the extension of the garden which is available for the benefit of patients and staff.

The wildflower garden which located next to Car Park A won a Silver Gilt Award and Best Show Garden.
