The organisation is responsible for:

- Taking action where there are concerns about an attorney, deputy or guardian
- [Registering lasting and enduring powers of attorney](#), enabling people to choose who makes decisions on their behalf
- Maintaining the registers of attorneys, deputies and guardians
- Supervising deputies and guardians appointed by the courts and ensuring they carry out their legal duties
- Investigating reports of abuse involving registered attorneys, deputies or guardians
