Alzheimer's Society dementia awareness training to launch across WUTH

We are pleased to announce the launch of a new CPD-accredited dementia awareness training programme, developed by the Alzheimer's Society and aligned to Tier 2 and Tier 3 of the Dementia Training Standards Framework.

The programme marks an important step forward in strengthening dementia care across WUTH and ensuring colleagues have the knowledge, skills and confidence to provide high-quality, person-centred care for people living with dementia.

As part of the programme, 12 members of staff have successfully completed a Train-the-Trainer course, equipping them to deliver dementia awareness training across the Trust.

Training will begin from the first week of September and will initially be rolled out to clinical staff who are most likely to support patients living with dementia, before expanding more widely across the organisation.

The programme aims to:

- Increase staff knowledge and confidence in supporting people living with dementia
- Improve the experience, safety and outcomes of patients with dementia while in our care
- Ensure colleagues are trained in line with nationally recognised dementia training standards
- Promote compassionate, person-centred and evidence-based dementia care across all services

Dementia affects many of the patients and families who access our services. By investing in accredited education, WUTH is strengthening its ability to recognise, understand and respond to the needs of people living with dementia while supporting carers and families throughout their healthcare journey.
