New mandatory Medical Gases Training on ESR

A new Medical Gases Training requirement has now been implemented on ESR for all Registered Nurses and Midwives.

The training is a mandatory Role Essential requirement and has been introduced to ensure Registered Nurses and Midwives maintain the knowledge required for the safe use and management of medical gases in clinical practice.

The training consists of a single 25-minute eLearning video and must be completed annually to maintain compliance.

MEDICAL GASES TRAINING IS NOW MANDATORY

- Mandatory Role Essential training** for all Registered Nurses and Midwives.
- 25-minute e-learning video** to be completed **annually**.
- Completion recorded automatically** on ESR and monitored through the Trust's compliance reporting arrangements.
- Managers:** Please support your teams to complete training and routinely review compliance.

What do I need to do?

Managers are also asked to support colleagues in completing the training within the required timescales and to routinely review compliance across their teams.
