

How do I obtain the full text of a journal article?

You can search for journals which are subscribed to by the Library and Knowledge Service OR are part of the NHS Core Content at:

www.evidence.nhs.uk

You will need an Open Athens account to access this resource.

See Library Helpsheet No. 1 for creating an Open Athens Account.

Simple steps to access journal articles:

1. Go to www.evidence.nhs.uk.
2. Select Journals and Databases
3. Select A-Z list of available journals
4. Select OpenAthens Login and when prompted, enter your Open Athens user name and password.
5. Enter the name of the journal you are looking for in the Search box.

If the page tells you that the journal is 'Available in print at McArdle Library, Arrowe Park Hospital / Library, Clatterbridge Cancer Centre', you can access the full text by visiting the Library.

Find the journal on the shelf. You can make a copy of the article you require in the Library.
Please ensure you are aware of current copyright legislation.

If the page tells you that the journal is Available from a platform such as Proquest, MEDLINE Complete etc., you can access the full text by selecting the link to the platform.
Please note the date range of access and any user name and password details.

Browse the Table of Contents and follow the links to access the PDF (Portable Document Format) of the article you require.
You can print a copy of the article you require in the Library

If you cannot find the article you require:
